**Tribal woman from Hatia shuns marriage, family life to care for and teach differently abled children**

## She chose to be a special mentor, not a mother

The just-concluded Jharkhand State Games (for all disabilities) in Jamshedpur turned the spotlight on the sporting skills of hundreds of special children, but what perhaps deserves equal attention, if not more, is the silent contribution of those who have taken that extra step to nurture these youngsters.

One such mentor is Sheela Linda, a tribal woman from Ranchi, who shunned family life to fulfil a social obligation — that is care for the deaf and mute and mentally challenged children, mainly hailing from slum areas.

Marriage and motherhood were not important to the 38-year-old social worker hailing from Chandni Chowk in Hatia, 10km from Ranchi. Teaching differently abled children was Linda's NGO Prakash Kuni, which was set up in 1998, at present has 34-odd special students and sent nine of them to take part in the national meet for the disabled organised by the state unit of Special Olympics Bharat. The three-day event ended at JRD Tata Sports Complex on Sunday.

"Five of my sisters and a brother are happily married. I face a lot of pressure from my parents, as they wanted me to also get married and settled. My father even asked me to adopt a child. But I refused. They don't raise the topics now, as they know that I have decided to dedicate my life to these children who need extra care and help to shine in life," said the qualified physical trainer.

Speaking about her NGO that runs from a dingy room of a community centre, Sheela

said there were slums, having a number of mentally challenged and found children, all around it.

"Parents of these children come to me for help. I take them under my wings and teach them basic lessons via sign language. I am happy that one of my students has won medals in national and state sports meets. He also passed matriculation with division this year. Many others are now making a living by working on MGN projects," a proud Sheela said.

The social worker lives alone in a small room and sells candles, pens, sticks, rakhis et al to generate funds for her NGO. "My students arrived in these products. I require Rs 10,000 per month to run my centre. We show just our meagre earnings. We have never received any aid from the state," said, as she also took up odd jobs like weaving and stitching.

Just a matriculate, Linda has no regrets about not pursuing higher studies, and the plight of children in Hatia moved me. I was inclined to go for her and decided to do something for the cause of special children. Later, I came with this setting up an NGO," Sheela said.

No wonder, many like a fellow teacher at Prakash Kuni, Sapna Debnath, is from the path-breaker. "She has set an example. Nobody in this community would sacrifice her life for the cause of the disabled," Sapna said.

Special Olympics Bharat's assistant area director, Jharkhand, Dr. Singh saluted Sheela. "She is a brave woman, who is changing the life of a

## **HUMAN RESOURCE POLICY:**

*A well-laid-out HR manual containing modern management principles guides the organization in all spheres of HR functions comprising recruitment, appointment, job responsibilities, remuneration, increment, leave entitlements, statutory compliance, up-gradation of management skills, disciplinary behavior, and resignation termination and exit interview. These enable the individuals concerned to bring forth their best for the betterment of the organization.*







### *procurement Policy:*

A transparent procurement policy is followed by the organization for the purchase of all materials required for program implementation and office requirements. Competitive quotations are invited and the same are compiled and studied before finalization of orders without making a compromise for quality and price. For procurement of large-scale items, advertisements are issued in newspapers inviting tenders. Comparative studies are conducted and negotiations are done with shortlisted parties to further economize on rates so that precious resources are not spent wastefully.



## Financial Policy:

Prudent financial policy is pursued to ensure transparency. A computerized financial package (tally system), is in place which ensures accuracy. Bank accounts are maintained with Nationalized Bank. Further program-specific accounts are opened and operated as per the guidelines and requirements of any of the concerned projects. Annual accounts are invariably audited by Chartered Accountants and the same is published for the information of all concerned





# Rapport and Liaison of the organization

The organization maintains good rapport and liaison with various government departments as well as Ranchi district administration at all levels who have been always helping the organization in implementing programs. It also continues to maintain good liaison with all the funding organizations that have supported the organizations not only in the past but also under the ongoing program. Further at the grass-root level close coordination is maintained with social activists, community leaders, etc.





# FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

*As far as financial management is concerned, the organization is guided by transparency in operations. A computerized accounting System is in place and tally software is implemented for accounting purposes. A monthly financial statement is prepared to monitor the financial status of each project. All the accounts (Cashbook and ledgers) are maintained on a daily basis. For different projects, separate books of accounts, and records are maintained and the same are audited by an external auditor. The organization has bank accounts in a nationalized bank and further need-based bank accounts are opened and operated by the organization. Periodical reports are generated for future purposes and submitted to project sanctioning authorities as per guidelines*





# TECHNICAL MANAGEMENT

*The management information system in the organization keeps the board of members informed about all financial and program implementation activities in the organization. Regular monthly meetings are conducted with the concerned project/office staff for reviewing the program activities. Detailed deliberations are conducted in the meetings and decisions are arrived at after reaching a consensus on major issues. The reporting relationship is also maintained both upwards and downwards with a regular flow of information. The board also reviews the work of the organization and gives necessary direction based on feedback from the field.*

# SKILL & VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME:

One of the important activities of the NGO has been the promotion of handicrafts. Handicrafts provide a livelihood to a large number of people across the country particularly the people who are low educated but have the wood skill to create beautiful things their imaginary capacity needs to be encouraged to come forward. this can be done if carrying out such activities results in slum areas. the economic benefits his society is extending to the artisans. the organization provides raw materials to these artisans gets the handicraft product ready and then sale them in the market using its own network and marketing systems





## SC/OBC AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

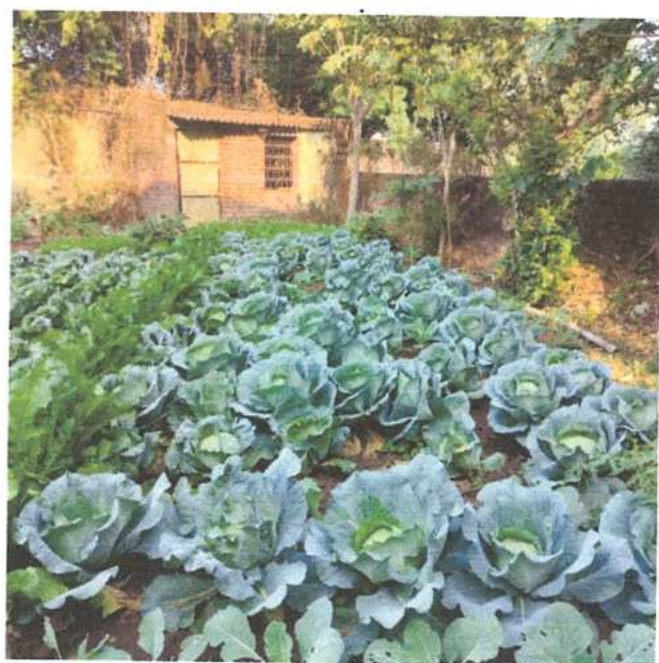

# Awareness of HIV AIDS

*Increasing the number of HIV AIDS patients in the state is a subject of anxiety. PK has started the work on the Link Worker Scheme in the Ranchi Intervention Project with the help of the Jharkhand State Aids Control Committee to combat the critique situation.*

# PROGRAM

*PK sees its voluntary intervention as a four-major program to achieve objectives. All these programs are linked with awareness building, organization building, and capacity development and ensure access to services at the village level*





## Safe Drinking Water, Sanitation and Hygiene

These three components are very important to establish a healthy society, but people are not sensitive to safe drinking water due to the lack of awareness. PK organized street play in 05 villages to mobilize and awaken people to construct toilets, start hygiene practices, and wider advertisement of the National Drinking Water Pipe Water Supply Scheme under Maryada Abhiyan at the district level. As a result of our initiative, more than 32 families constructed new toilets in their houses and about 300 families submitted demand within 2 months from the start of the program. People awoke through a wider message about the disadvantages of open defecation and washing hands before eating and after the toilet. We also mobilized about approx 300 people about hygiene practices.



## **Human Resource Management of PK**

*The human resource development policy of Prakash Kunj focuses on a holistic development approach of man force. PK gives equal importance to the satisfaction of the group, the quality of the program and management, innovative ideas, effective implementation, and monitoring.*

*Selection, appointment, training for staff capacity development, evaluation and management, progress and transfer, and keeping individual records of workers, salaries, honorarium, and other allowances and assessment of their performance are included in the HR policy*



### **Awareness of Tuberculosis Disease**

*Some populations of the Ranchi district work in stone mining; for a reason, they are afraid of being infected by tuberculosis disease, and some mining laborers are affected by tuberculosis. In this situation, PK is generating awareness among Stone query villagers through regular meetings. Identification of people infected with tuberculosis, free health checks, and health-related government schemes information provided to them with the help of the Voluntary Health Association of Jharkhand. 980 men and women from 48 villages participated in these meetings organized on this program*



# Environmental Awareness

Deforestation and pollution of the environment are the main reasons for climate change and emerging challenges from it. Because of this, So many natural disasters are happening around us. The misbalancing of the environment and ecology has become a more concerning subject for the entire world. PK organized awareness rallies, poster competitions, exhibitions, and tree plantation programs from time to time to generate awareness of the environment. Villagers planted 756 trees in 02 villages after the awareness program of the organization. Also, efforts were made in the "Plastic Free Village" in Ranchi village by getting their attention as well as providing information on the disadvantages of the use of plastic bags.





## Conservation of Energy

Consumption and demands of energy are increasing day by day as well as population as a result energy supply is becoming more challenging. It is necessary to be aware people about the traditional and optional sources of energy to balance consumption, demand, and supply of energy and reduce the consumption of energy. In this conjunction, PK builds awareness of the conservation of energy and the use of C.F.L.





# Water Conservation

The main reasons for depleting groundwater are exploitation of groundwater and lack of awareness about water conservation. Discussions were held on different ways of water conservation like farm bunding and stopping the dam. A small change dam was constructed with 10 pocket grains of sand in Ranchi village. Water is conserved in this village as a result, of this earthen dam, and the availability of water is ensured for the drinking of cattle and irrigation purposes





# ROAD SAFETY AWARENESS PROGRAM

We have made this program of Road Safety Awareness by making 500 people aware and in a radius of 7 kilometers, in 1500 vehicles. Many people of the village helped to do this program in Ranchi city. The right to life and safety is a fundamental right of any citizen. This is guaranteed under the constitutions of every country in the world including India. Anything, that is hazardous to humans, violates the right to life, and road safety is as much on the agenda as any other area, which may be accident-prone. More people die every year from road accidents all over the world than the number killed during the whole of the Second World War. Studies by the World Bank have estimated that about 5,00,000 people lose their lives each year as a result of road accidents and over 15 million suffer injuries.

About 70% of these occur in developing countries, particularly African and Asian countries constitutes one percent of annual Gross National Product resources, which they can not afford. A look at some of the statistics on road safety presents a very grim picture worldwide and especially in developing countries like India. Road fatalities now lead the list of accidental deaths in India much more than any other accidental deaths such as by drowning, fire, rail or air mishaps etc. The magnitude of road accidents in India is increasing at an alarming rates.





## OLD AGE HOME PROGRAM

The old age home program is important for the development of society and for the future of the nation. Prakash Kunj is sincere in this direction by establishing an old age home development center at Ranchi in Jharkhand offering vocational and flexible education programs for those above 60 years old. The center aims to engage young people through interactive Health & Social Care





## Girls Education

*Girls play an important role and place in the society.*

*A girl becomes a woman and operates the entire family. Educated girls are the backbone of the family as well as society. PK organizes meetings with the guardians of schoolchildren to raise awareness of girls' education intensively in Ranchi.*





# CHILD EDUCATION PROGRAMME

*The child Education Programme was organized for Literacy Awareness for 250 beneficiaries. The poor and illiterate beneficiaries were made aware of the importance of education and information was provided on how and where they can access free education.*





# **CLEANLINESS & CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM**

We have done the Cleanliness and Consumer Awareness Program with 3000 people. We have organized this program everywhere by going to hotels and public places, including village and city people in Ranchi town. This study attempts to investigate the customers' perceptions of restaurant cleanliness. Understanding what customers consider when they evaluate a restaurant's cleanliness can be beneficial for hospitality managers who can use the information to increase their restaurant's quality and satisfy their customers. In addition, this study was conducted with two different cultural groups of customers: Westerners and Asians. Understanding how different cultures perceive restaurant cleanliness can help hospitality managers who plan to expand their business in the global market.

The level of importance of restaurant cleanliness dimensions was found to be similar between the Western and Asian samples. The server's behavior, restroom appearance, and signage were found to be the most important dimensions for both groups. However, restroom personal hygiene was found to be the only dimension ranked differently by the two groups in the study. Westerners weighed restroom personal hygiene as more important than Asian respondents. Asian groups were found to have higher expectations for overall restaurant cleanliness dimensions than Western groups.





## Organic Farming

Using chemical fertilizers and pesticides is contaminating grain, vegetables, fruits, and milk which are the main base of the food for human life. As a result, human life is falling in a dangerous situation. Indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizers for crop growing has become a threat to human life as well and this is converting productive land into barren land. Only one solution against this situation is organic farming, it proves that vermin compost is helpful to increase the production power of the earth. It makes water, land, and air healthy and farming in low water availability is possible by using vermin compost also it is cheaper than chemical fertilizer, and it decreases the cost of farming. Bringing these objectives PK motivated farmers for organic farming in Ranchi village through awareness.



# Access to Government Schemes through Awareness

People from underprivileged communities are capable that they can access different government schemes and their rights under organization-building and capacity development programs through awareness. As a result, the following is the progress in this field-

- 38 families get Below Poverty Line cards after the listing, as well as 05 family cards made under the Deen Dayal Antyoday Anna Scheme.
- 34 women benefited from the widow pension scheme and 167 men and women benefited from the old age pension scheme.
- Girls from 05 families got benefits from the Ladali Lakshmi Scheme.
- 09 families got benefits under the Indira Awas Yojana (Indira House Scheme).
- 07 landless laborers got the benefit of Mukhya Mantri Mazdoor Surkasha Yojana (Chief Minister Labour Security Scheme).
- 03 families got benefits under the National Family Aid Scheme.
- 06 farmers got benefits and constructed well on their farms, now they are cultivating their irrigated land
- 15 women got benefits from Janani Suraksha Yojana at the time of delivery of their pregnancy.
- 08 girls married under the Mukhya Mantri Kanyadan Yojana.
- 05 marginal farmers got benefits under the agriculture gram demonstration scheme of the agriculture department
- 4 marginal farmers got assistance for the plantation of fruit trees from the horticulture department.
- 02 women mobilized to adopt family planning

रांची, 16 सितंबर : सुदीप तितली कहां है, सात वर्षीय मंदबुद्धि बालक से उसकी मां पूछती है. बालक मां को देखता है व कुछ हर्कतें करने लगता है, फिर उठ कर दीवार पर बने चित्रों में से तितली को बने चित्र पर हाथ रख देता है. यह बातों में इरिया स्थित प्रकाश कुंज नामक संस्था की. यह संस्था मंदबुद्धि बच्चों का जीवन संभालने में लगा हुआ है. आठ दिसंबर 1999 को स्थापित उक्त संस्था में आसपास के इलाकों जैसे तुपुनारा, बिरसा चौक, सतर्जोली, सोलंकी, रातू आदि के अलावा अन्य क्षेत्र के मंदबुद्धि बच्चे आते हैं. कुछ युवा मंदबुद्धि युवक-युवातियां भी हैं. इन्हें दैनिक कार्यकलापों की जानकारी दी जाती है. जैसे ब्रजा काना, नहाना आदि. पहले उक्त संस्था पटेल नगर में कार्यरत था. कुछ दिन पूर्व यह यहां के सामुदायिक भवन में कार्य कर रहा है. यहां बच्चों को अक्षरों व चित्रों के माध्यम से पढ़ाया भी जाता है. बिना कोई शुल्क के. तो फिर आसपास संस्था कैसे चलती है, पूछे जाने पर शीला लिंडा कहती हैं किसी तरह चलता है. सरकारी की ओर से कोई सहायता अब तक मिली है. वो कहती हैं अब तक तो नहीं. फिर आजकल इसके लिए पैरी चाहिए. ओ हमारे पास नहीं है. हमने हरिया के ही कुछ प्रतिष्ठित लोगों को सहायता देने को कहा, लेकिन किसी ने ध्यान नहीं दिया. शीला कहती हैं मुझे समाज के लिए कुछ करने की तमना है, इसलिए कर रही हूं. इस कार्य में उसकी बहन वेनू लिंडा, कुसुम देवी, अनिता तिकी, गीता कर्माली, निशा लिंडा व चौगा तिकी भी सहयोग करती हैं. उनका कहना है कि इसी कार्य में लगी संस्था दीर्घायिका ने उन्हें बहुत सहायता किया. वहां मैंने ट्रेनिंग भी ली. यहां शॉल बनाने की ट्रेनिंग भी दी जाती है. इन शॉलों को वे बाजार में घूम-घूम कर बेचती हैं व इससे होनेवाली आमदनी से संस्था का खर्च चलता है. इसमें और कुछ मंदबुद्धि बच्चों की मर्यादाओं ने कहा कि यहां आने से बच्चे अब घर में कम बहमाशी करते हैं, रोजमर्रा का काम खुद करते हैं. बीच में ही बात काट कर बच्चों को शिक्षा देनेवाली कुसुम देवी कहती हैं और यही संस्था का उद्देश्य है।

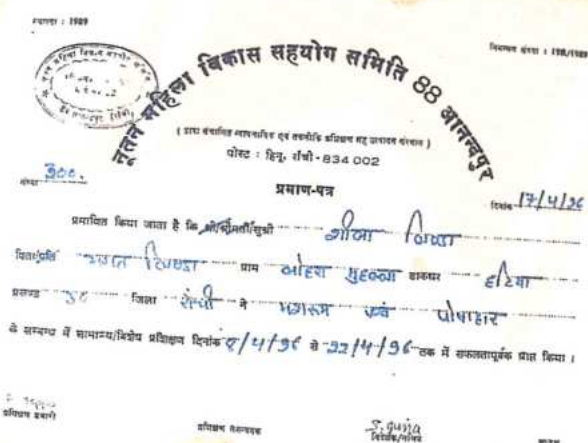
